Scope of service to livestock and poultry

- Conducts laboratory tests on specimens from livestock and poultry as well as their environment.
- Provides accurate, timely, critical information to assist owners, producers and veterinarians in effectively managing the health of individual animals, herds or flocks.
- Facilitates commerce by providing testing required for international, interstate or intrastate shipment of livestock and poultry.
- Conducts research to improve existing testing procedures, develop new diagnostic tests, and study new or unusual diseases.
- Maintains Biosafety Level 3 veterinary diagnostic laboratories at its College Station and Amarillo facilities; these labs are equipped to respond to the detection of high-consequence animal diseases that could threaten the state's agriculture economy.
